Ormiston Chadwick Academy ensured that all students in 2015/16 left with an offer of a college place, apprenticeship or employment.

Checks are made continuously throughout the academic year to prevent any students becoming NEET. Updates in September2017 showed that 2 of our students are now showing as NEET (AW & BB). Of these one student has recently given birth, the second student has been experiencing anxiety issues and is currently receiving support through the NEET team. She is looking at returning to education on a part time basis. The Academy remains proactive in keeping in touch with those identified as likely to become NEET.

All but 2 students have been offered a college place or apprenticeship for September 2017.
