

HOW IS KS4 GRADED?




- A numerical system of Grades 1-9 for GSCEs
- A Pass, Merit, Distinction, Distinction* for BTECs and other vocational qualifications
- The government gave your a target for your GCSEs based on your KS2 results
- It's a number and this is their estimated point score, an average is 50.
- This figure is used to track their <u>progress</u> across the 2 years at Key Stage 4.

PROGRESS 8:



- Each qualification a student takes is worth points.
- But you can only use your <u>8 best</u> and there are limitations only certain subjects can sit in each basket.
- The aim is to get enough points across the baskets to exceed your estimated score

• This will give you a **POSITIVE PROGRESS**




HOW YOU WORK YOUR P8 OUT:




- Add up the total of the <u>8</u>
 <u>best subjects</u>
- Take this away from the government expected total point score
- <u>Divide</u> the remainder by
 <u>10</u> this is progress 8

Worked example



- Pupil has ave KS2
 En & Ma score of 4.9
- National ave for this
 KS2 score = 54
- Difference = 67 54= 13
- So Progress 8 score
 for this pupil
 = 13 / 10 = 1.3
- Progress 8 score for school = average of pupil Progress 8 scores





YOUR CHOICES:






- Make sure they are <u>your</u> choices don't copy friends!!
