

# Digital Safeguarding - Conduct

## What it is

- Digital safeguarding is all about keeping yourself and others safe when online. Conduct is one aspect of digital safeguarding this is about your personal behaviour that increases the likelihood of, or causes harm; for example, making, sending and receiving explicit images (e.g. consensual and non consensual sharing of nudes and semi nudes and/or pornography) sharing pornography, sharing other explicit images and online bullying

## Signs

- People spend a lot of time on computers
- People don't want to access or use technology
- Improper searches
- People become isolated
- People may become withdrawn

## What to do

- Log your concerns on cpoms pass the slip to one of the DSL's
- Listen to the student and never judge
- Use the buttons on school website to report inappropriate content
