

HOW IS KS4 GRADED?




- A numerical system of Grades 1-9 for GSCEs
- A Pass, Merit, Distinction, Distinction* for BTECs and other vocational qualifications
- Your child will receive a target for your GCSEs/BTECs based on their KS2 results & CATs tests.
- It's a number and this is their estimated point score, an average is 50.
- This figure is used to track their <u>progress</u> across the 2 years at Key Stage 4.

PROGRESS 8:



- Each qualification a student takes is worth points.
- But you can only use your <u>8 best</u> and there are limitations only certain subjects can sit in each basket.
- The aim is to get enough points across the baskets to exceed your estimated score

• This will give you a **POSITIVE PROGRESS**




HOW YOU WORK YOUR P8 OUT:




- Add up the total of the <u>8</u>
 <u>best subjects</u>
- <u>Take this away</u> from the expected total point score
- <u>Divide</u> the remainder by
 <u>10</u> this is progress 8


Worked example



- Pupil has ave KS2
 En & Ma score of 4.9
- National ave for this KS2 score = 54
- Difference = 67 54 = 13
- So Progress 8 score
 for this pupil
 = 13 / 10 = 1.3
- Progress 8 score for school = average of pupil Progress 8 scores







ATTAINMENT 8:




- Attainment 8 is a way of measuring how well pupils do in key stage 4.
- This is regardless of any KS2 scores/results.
- The 8 subjects which make up Attainment 8 include English and maths. Out of the remaining 6 subjects:
- 3 must come from Bucket 2 e.g. sciences, language and humanities
- 3 qualifications can be any other approved subject

HOW YOU WORK YOUR A8 OUT:

• Each grade a pupil gets is assigned a point score from 9 (the highest) to 1 (the lowest).

AGE QUOD AGIS


- Each pupil's Attainment 8 score is calculated by adding up the points for their 8 subjects, with English and maths counted twice (double).
- Attainment 8 scores are rounded to 1 decimal place.








- Make sure they are <u>your</u> choices don't copy friends!!





Attendance Triangle
