
### SAME SEX PARENTS

### **ADULTERY**

When someone is married but has a sexual relationship with someone else.

This is considered by many people to be betrayal of trust and completely breaks the promise made when the couple married that they would not have relations with anyone



### COHABITATION

When a couple lives together without being married. In countries like Britain this is common place and many people think it is a good idea as it gives people the chance to see if they really are suited before they get married

In Muslim countries, co-habitation is not allowed. Some people do not approve of cohabitation as they believe that living with a partner and having a sexual relationship with them is something that should be saved for marriage to keep it special.

## **MARRIAGE**

Many Christians may choose to get married because it is a sacrament and an important commitment between themselves. their husband/wife and God. Marriage within Christianity should be monogamous (between two people) and should be treated as a gift from God.



This is not the same as a forced marriage, according to Islamic teaching, sons and daughters have the right to refuse their parents choice for them.

#### WOMEN'S BRAINS AND MEN'S BRAINS Research has shown that men's and women's
