2 Minims are equal to 4 beats


4 Crotchets are equal to 4 beats

8 Quavers are equal to 4 beats

16 Semiquavers are equal to 4 beats

	1/4 + 1/4 + 1/4 + 1/4 = 1


Staff Notation - Treble Clef and Simple Melody making

Polyrhythm

a rhythm which makes use of two or more different [rhythms](#) simultaneously

Loops / Ostinatos

a continually repeated musical phrase or rhythm – loops with tech

Call & Response

a compositional technique, often a succession of two distinct phrases that works like a conversation in music.

Rhythm – an irregular pattern of notes

Beat – a constant pulse that runs through the music

Tempo – the speed of the music

Samples - a clip of existing music – audio

Midi – a computer generated sound – this can be edited more easily than audio.
