#### **Bias**


To present a story from one viewpoint without considering the other side of the story.

## **Positive bias**

only focuses on the good things about the subject, not mention any or mentioning few of the downsides.

## **Negative bias**

presents a story to cause unnecessary worry by focussing on or showing the negative aspects of a story.





#### **Misinformation**

information which is false, but is not created or shared with the intention of causing harm

### **Malinformation**

truthful information which is deliberately shared in an effort to harm a person or group

#### Disinformation

information which is deliberately created and shared to harm a person or group
