Humanism, Paganism & Wicca

Humanists believe that there is no God, but that human life is still special, because it is so short. They believe the purpose of life is to enjoy it and to do things which make us happy whilst helping others to also live their best lives.



Paganism refers to a group of religions e.g. Wicca who believe that nature should be worshipped. E.g. the sun & moon. Practitioners of paganism, particularly wicca, will often refer to themselves as witches. They believe in positive thinking and manifesting, too.

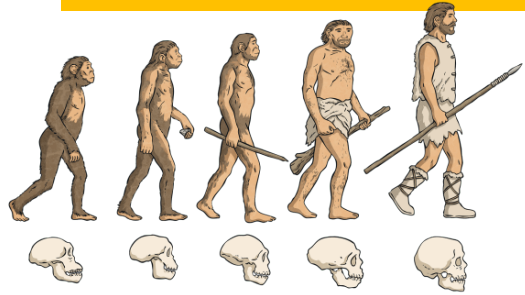

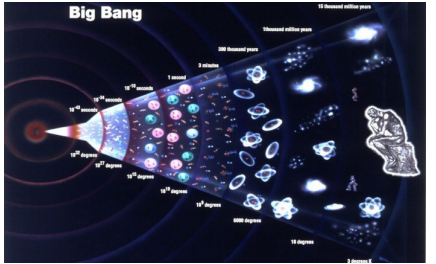
Atheist - Someone who doesn't believe in God
